POSITION DESCRIPTION Executive Director of Special Services

Position Description

The Executive Director of Special Services works as a member of the Educational Services team to ensure student academic achievement. Under the supervision of the Superintendent, the Executive Director of Special Services is responsible for the development, coordination and facilitation of Special Education and categorical programs. The Executive Director supports individual sites in academic response to intervention, inclusive educational services as well as self contained programs. This position coordinates with other departments to ensure available educational services and supports, and to provide assistance in meeting district, state, and federal accountability requirements through innovative approaches and models. The Executive Director also provides professional learning, leadership coaching and mentoring to educators in collaboration with other members of the leadership team.

Essential Job Functions

- Establishes and evaluates district goals, priorities, processes and systems for the effective delivery of educational support services.
- Manages various professional learning leadership projects related to the delivery of services across the district.
- Plans and facilitates various events that directly support staff and students in areas such as
 differentiated teaching and learning, inclusive educational practices, and developing English
 language.
- Collaborates with and supports the administrative team concerning their special education programs.
- Oversees, develops and delivers professional development to a variety of stakeholders.
- Monitors the assessment processes and reviews data pertinent to educational decision making.
- Assists the Superintendent in the management and supervision of programs within the Educational Services Department.

Minimum Requirements

- Valid teacher certification
- Administration certificate or ability to obtain certification
- At least 5 years of classroom teaching experience with demonstrated effectiveness in content area, use of standards-based curriculum, instruction, and assessment
- Legal authorization to work in the U.S.

- Knowledge and experience in managing categorical programs
- Experience with coaching and designing/facilitating professional development opportunities
- Demonstrated ability to work collaboratively with an emphasis on effective communication

- Demonstrated leadership qualities in curriculum, instruction, assessment, professional development, and effective management
- Knowledge of Child Find, IDEA and Section 504 including processes related to the identification, evaluation, qualification, and compliance.
